Corona Virus COVID-19 Alert Level 2

Dear Owners and Residents,

President Ramaphosa announced that ALERT level 2 will come into effect from midnight on Monday, the 17th of August 2020.

The following changes will take effect under level 2:

- All restrictions on inter-provincial travel will be lifted.
- Accommodation, hospitality venues and tours will be permitted according to approved protocols to ensure social distancing.
- Restaurants, bars and taverns will be permitted to operate according to approved protocols as to times of operation and numbers of people.
- Restrictions on the sale of tobacco will be lifted.
- The suspension of the sale of alcohol will be lifted subject to certain restrictions.
- Alcohol will be permitted for on-site consumption in licensed establishments only up until 10pm.
- Liquor outlets will be allowed to sell alcohol for off-site consumption from Monday to Thursday during the hours of 9Am to 5pm only.
- Restrictions on family and social visits will also be lifted, although everyone is urged to exercise extreme caution and undertake such visits only if necessary.

The following restrictions will remain in place:

- Current restrictions on international travel will remain in place.
- No gatherings of more than 50 people will be permitted. Among others, this includes funerals and religious events.
- Spectators will not be permitted at sporting events.
- The curfew will remain in place between the hours of 10pm and 4am.

It would be an understatement to say that as a country, we have had to endure much over the last few months to reach this new level of freedom. The effect has been devastating and the news that we will be moving to alert level 2 has been welcomed by millions of South Africans.

In saying this, we should not allow ourselves to become too complacent under the new alert level 2. Residents are encouraged to continue to do their part by maintaining a safe social distance from others, to wash and sanitize their hands on a regular basis, and to wear a mask when in public (open spaces) which includes the common property areas in the estate.

The recreational area/s within the complex will be open for use by residents under alert level 2. The rules surrounding the use of the area/s will be subject to the complex rules (as per normal)
e.g. the number of persons permitted to use the area, formal booking procedures, noise rules and government regulations in terms of hygiene and social management.

Further to the use of the recreational area/s, such area/s must be vacated by no later than 21h30 due to the 22h00 curfew imposed by government. The common areas are cleaned weekly by EEM however it will be the responsibility of the resident and / their visitors to sanitize any common areas they will make use of (especially over a weekends).
